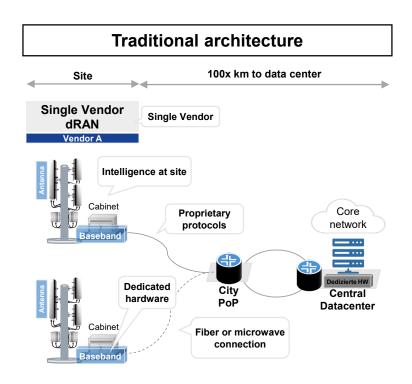

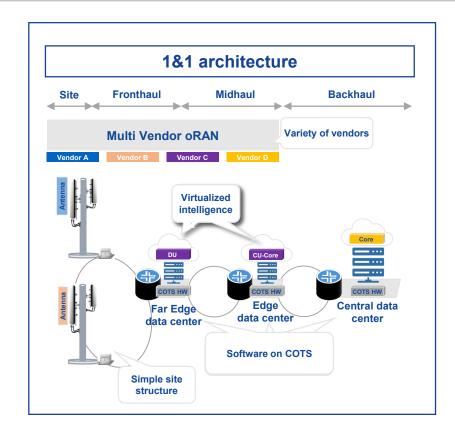

dRAN = Distributed RAN; oRAN = Open RAN; CU = Centralized Unit; DU = Distributed Unit; COTS = components off-the-shelf (serial products); EDGE Data Center (COTS locations geographically distributed in the network); Far EDGE Data Center (Sites in the nearest City POP); Fronthaul (Antennas connection); Midhaul (Connection of the City POPs); Backhaul (Transport network with connection to the Central Data Center)

Acceptance of the offer for National Roaming



- 1&1 Drillisch has accepted the offer of Telefónica Deutschland as of 5 February, 2021
 - July 1, 2020 until June 30, 2025
 - Prolongation option until 30 June 2029 according to defined rules
 - Second renewal option of up to 5 years at non-discriminatory prices, negotiating in good faith
 - Price agreement retroactively from 1 July 2020 (also for MBA MVNO business reference)
 - Price development based on the methodology of the first 5 years (especially falling data price)
 - MBA MVNO services include unchanged 5G network coverage; after 5G network goes live, national roaming includes 2G/3G/4G
- Continuing right for yearly price reviews

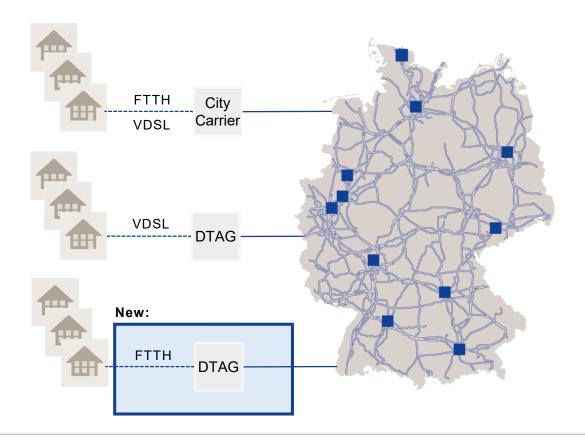


VDSL and FTTH

New cooperation with 1&1 Versatel and Deutsche Telekom (1) 1&1 DRILLISCH



- VDSL and FTTH complete package including Voice, IP-TV from a single source via 1&1 Versatel
- Fiber optic coverage expanded to home connections of Deutsche Telekom , in addition new VDSL contract



Transport network and value-added services

1&1 Versatel

Regional networks / last mile

- VDSL-Vectoring through Deutsche Telekom (mainly Layer 2)
- Optic fibre (FTTH) via City Carrier
- New: Approx. 750,000 FTTH connections via Deutsche Telekom; Number to yearly increase by approx. 2 million households

New cooperation with 1&1 Versatel and Deutsche Telekom (2) 1&1 DRILLISCH



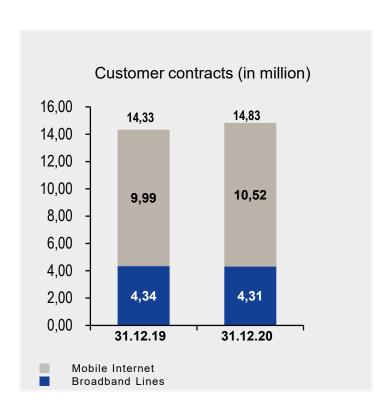
- 1 April 2021 to 31 March 2031
- Attractive conditions
- Termination of the existing contingent contracts (VDSL), resulting in a write-off for remaining available contingents amounting to €130 million
- Derecognition is non-cash effective and will be significantly exceeded in the long term by positive effects from the expanded cooperation with 1&1 Versatel and Deutsche Telekom
- New VDSL/FTTH agreement between 1&1 Versatel and Deutsche Telekom is subject to approval of the Federal Network Agency (Bundesnetzagentur)

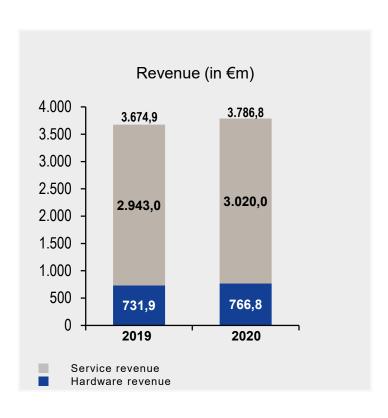




- 14.83m customer contracts (+ 050m)

 - 4.31m broadband lines (- 0.03m)

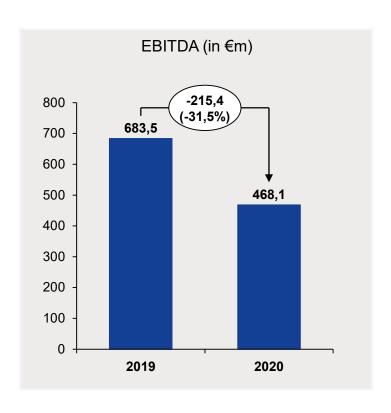
Revenue





- + 3.0 % Revenue to €3,786.8m
 - + 2.6 % Service revenue to €3,020.0m
 (+ 3.4 % adjusted for coronavirus effects,
 particularly due to lower international roaming)
 - + 4.8 % Other revenue, mostly low-margin hardware business

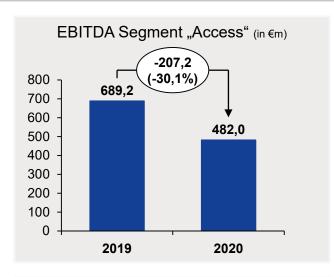


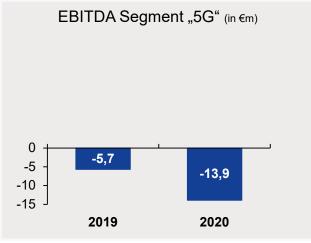


- 31.5 % EBITDA to €468.1m

Segment "Access"

- €482m EBITDA, comprising ca. €203m special factors
 - €130.0m one-off unused VDSL contingent*
 - = €34.4m from overcharge Telefónica wholesale billing (expected to be charged to other periods in 2021)
 - – €25.2m due to coronavirus-pandemic
 - €8.2m regulation (TAL increase)
 - €5.5m regulation (SMs cost)

Segment "5G"

– €13.9m EBITDA drawing from initial activities

^{*} The existing VDSL wholesale contract (1&1 Drillisch and Deutsche Telekom) was terminated earlier in view of the advantages of the new contract constellation, this resulted in the write-off of an accrued asset for contingents still available for use, which is to be amortized in the amount of €130m without an impact on cash.



Forecast FY 2021

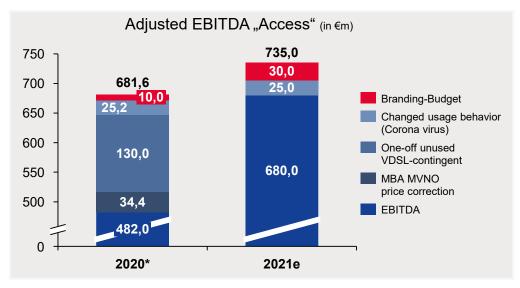
Forecast 2021



- Service revenue: ca. €3.1bn (previous year: ca. €3.02bn)
- EBITDA: ca. €650m (previous year: ca. €468,1 m, (after €203 m special factors)
- ca. €55m included in earnings forecast
 - ca. €30m initial 5G network costs
 - ca. €25m negative effects from the coronavirus pandemic
- Not included: ca. € 34,4 m positive effects from retroactive price adjustment of MBA MVNO wholesale services (expected to be booked in 2021 outside the period)

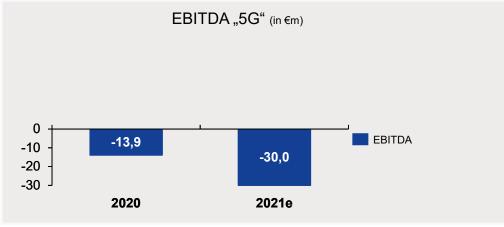
